## <u>Circular No.03 of 2017</u> <u>To all Units / Members,</u>

## 9<sup>th</sup> Triennial Circle General Council Meeting <u>A Grand Success</u>

As notified by this office, the 9<sup>th</sup> Triennial Circle General Council Meeting of the State Bank of India Staff Association, North Eastern Circle was held at Guwahati on 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2017. The Reception Committee formed for hosting the Circle General Council by Units/members of offices/branches of greater Guwahati made an excellent arrangement for smooth and successful conduct of the event. The venue of the meeting, the Gauhati Medical College Auditorium was beautifully decorated to give it a festive look during the Circle General Council Meeting.

The event started with hoisting of the Association's Flag by Com. Issues like lack of proper recruitment in banks and large corporate debts, etc., also came out in the deliberations of the speakers. Shri Murty, Hon'ble Chief General Manager of SBI, N.E. Circle, in his address, appreciated all employees of the bank for their dedicated service to the nation. He also urged upon the employees of the Bank to equip themselves to face the ever evolving challenges in the Banking Industry and to offer their best of efforts to retain the glory of our Bank and its number one position. Com. Rupam Roy, General Secretary of SBI Officers' Association, North Eastern Circle, stressed the need for the young generation to get actively involved in the trade union activities for their own benefits. He also emphasized human values and dignity in the working environment of the employees. Com.
