CONTRIBUTORY PROVIDENT FUND

"The issue of increase in contribution to Provident Fund by the employees as well as matching contribution by the Bank has been in discussion with the management since long subsequent to extension of provision of 12% contribution to the Government employees in the Pay Commission. However, improvements could not be made as the issue needs to be dealt at industry level since the scheme is available in some of the Public Sector Banks also.

2. In this connection, we inform that the above issue was included as one of the demands in Common Charter of Demands for discussions under 11th Bipartite Settlement and in terms of provisions under clause-17(d) of 11th Bipartite Settlement, it has been agreed that individual Banks may decide and fix at their level a higher percentage of contribution to Provident Fund.

3. Keeping in view the decision at IBA level, we request you to increase the contribution to Provident Fund by the employees at the rate of 12% of pay with matching contribution by the Bank for all the employees from Top Management to the Bottom with immediate effect.

4. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this communication and advise us the developments in the matter.

5. Please treat the matter as extremely urgent.
